1. the natural environment in which an animal or plant usually lives
2. the relationships between the air, land, water, animals, plants, etc., usually of a particular area, or the scientific study of this
3. to consider that someone has a particular quality
4. to give support, strength or a basic structure to something
5. to damage something so badly that it does not exist or cannot be used
6. the variability among living organisms (e.g. plant and animal species) that exist in a particular environmental area or in the world generally, or the problem of protecting this
7. to make someone less confident, less powerful or less likely to succeed, or to make something weaker, often gradually
8. to experience something which is unpleasant or which involves a change
9. a feeling of being unhappy because you are not satisfied with a particular situation
10. a feeling of being disappointed and unhappy because of discovering the truth about something or someone that you liked or respected
11. to encourage something to grow, develop or become active; to make someone excited and interested about something
12. to gradually change your behaviour and attitudes in order to be successful in a new situation
13. to put someone or something at risk or in danger of being harmed, damaged or destroyed
14. something which you do often and regularly, sometimes without knowing that you are doing it
15. a person or organization responsible for making certain that companies obey particular standards and do not act illegally
16. a group of experts brought together, usually by a government, to develop ideas on a particular subject and to make suggestions for action
17. something which causes part of the body to react
