6. an arrangement that somebody has with a bank, etc. to keep money there, take some out, etc
7. having doubts that a claim or statement is true or that something will happen
8. having been left by the people who owned or used it
9. to make an official examination of the accounts of a business and produce a report
10. an amount that is extra or more than you need
11. to formally promise to give or do something
12. power and influence over other people or events
13. the opposite of what you would expect or what seems to be obvious
14. designed to be used for one particular purpose
15. to make a new product, service, or system available for the first time
16. existing very commonly or happening often at a particular time or in a particular place
17. a group of people who try to persuade the government or an official group to do something
