To supervisors of postdoctoral researchers or 'over doctors', who are graduate students spending the time more than the defined years for obtaining their PhD degree.

We would like to take this opportunity to express our gratitude for your continued cooperation in graduate and undergraduate education. Since 2013 we have been conducting open recruitment postdoctoral researchers or 'over doctors', who are graduate students spending the time more than the defined years for obtaining their PhD degree and we are happy to report that we are currently actively recruiting again.

As this opportunity is one of "Employment Support Measures for postdoctoral researchers or 'over doctors', who are graduate students spending the time more than the defined years for obtaining their PhD degree in the Graduate School of Economics", only researchers who satisfy the following conditions are eligible to apply: who have obtained PhD degree or completed their coursework without PhD degree at Graduate School of Economics Kyoto University, and also who are not currently employed tenured position.

Note: We would like to stress that there is no guarantee that these positions will ensure that an appropriate VISAs can be obtained. We ask for candidates to carefully consider this point.

Junior researcher (researcher) Affiliation only for a period of 1 year (this post carries no salary or employment relationship)

We invite applications for each of three centers within the Graduate School of Economics (i.e. the Project Center, Center for East Asian Economic Studies, Economic Research Office).

As a principal there needs to be mutual understanding and agreement between the applicant and the center to which the applicant seeks to be affiliated regarding the applicant's research plan and purpose of their project. If successful in their application candidates are expected to both contribute to the promotion of research at each center and raise their own individual research achievements. Selection will be conducted on the basis of the research plan and achievements of applicants. Submission of papers to "経済論叢 Keizai-ronso" and "Kyoto Economic Review" and other academic journals are important criteria in the selection process, as are projects that are recognized as having potential in research fields related to those carried out at each of the Graduate School's project centers.
